## Supplies:

Stamp Sets: Layering Leaves \#161277
Paper: 2024-2026 In Color DSP
Ink Pads: In Color 2024-2026
Misc: Circle Punch 1 1/4", Paper Snips Scissors \#103579, a clip.
Adhesives: Tear \& Tape Adhesive \#154031, Dimensionals \#104430

## Measurements/Instructions:

The box base is $23 / 4$ " $\times 33 / 4$ "
Score on long side: $1^{\prime \prime}, 1$ 5/8", 2 5/8", 3 1/4"
Turn on the short side at $21 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
Flip over and on the opposite side, score $3 / 8$ "
(Please NOTE: I used Cardstock to show the process but I recommend DSP for the ease of folding and the way it looks. Perfect way to get rid of lots and lots of DSP sitting around. Go to the next page.


## Instructions cont:

+ Now, you need to cut off the pieces. The second picture shows me cutting and mitering. I also cut off just a little bit of the two tabs.
+ Adding adhesive: On the outside of the front, add Tear and tape to the big tab. Now flip over the first big bottom tab and add Tear and tape. Follow the pictures below.
+ I found these cute tiny Tic Tac boxes on Amazon. They are so Tiny!
+ To finish-You can always add embellishments.
+ Have fun making and have fun giving.


Remove the tape backing and put it together. Add a little Tic Tac Container and gently squeeze the box together from the side. I would Staple or find some clips to hold it together as I did.
